uPVC entrance door with display windows to each side with the benefit of external steel electric roller shutter with down lighters over the shop front leading through to

RETAIL AREA (4.4m x 4.2m)

With false ceiling with inset lighting. Numerous perimeter power points. Currently fitted with four work stations plus corner back wash with door leading through to

VESTIBULE

With door providing access to

WC with wash hand basin and tiled splash back. Central ceiling light. Obscure uPVC double glazed window overlooking the side of the property.

STORAGE AREA (2.7m x 1.3m)

With inset down lighters. Power points. Door leading through to

KITCHEN (3.1m x 1.6m)

Comprising stainless steel sink unit set into run of marble effect worktop with units below. Power points. Central ceiling light. Fire exit.

OUTSIDE TO THE REAR

To the rear of the property there is a small shared yard for housing of bins etc.

RATEABLE VALUE

The property is currently listed on the Valuation Office website as having a rateable value of £4,100 with the appropriate business rates multiplier to be applied for the business rates payable.

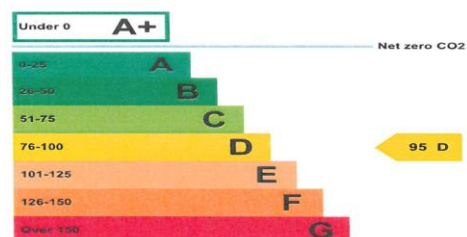
